

Sterling Hill Unacceptable Vehicles:

Any vehicle is to be considered unacceptable if it includes any of the below criteria:

- 1) Any Vehicle that has commercial or business signage on any part of it. (If the Commercial signage can be masked by a magnetic blank plate, or similar apparatus, but not larger than two feet by two feet, it shall be allowed, if the commercial signage is covered).**
- 2) Trucks over $\frac{3}{4}$ tons, as it pertains to hauling weight.**
- 3) A camper or van that has storage or cargo area over fourteen (14) feet in length.**
- 4) Vans with the seating for more than 9 passengers and used for business such as buses.**
- 5) A flatbed truck or box type truck.**
- 6) If a truck or van contains tool(s), construction material, construction waste, ladder(s) or portable fuel tanks in the bed of the truck.**
- 7) Fuel delivery truck or any other delivery type truck.**
- 8) A tow truck.**
- 9) A trailer with any of the above criteria.**
- 10) Covering an unacceptable vehicle with a tarpaulin or other cover does not make it acceptable.**

Note: Any vehicle is allowed on a temporary basis if the home site is being serviced, but the unacceptable vehicle cannot remain on the driveway or in the street overnight.
